CNC - Technician Program & Manage CNC MACHINE CENTRE



(Post Trade C7)

Course Program: This is a 12 month program plus project work and on-job learning, with tutorials at the PARTEC CNC Centre to validate CAM programs and do theory exams.

Registration: A unique training plan will be arranged for each student.
(Applications are now open for commencement at a convenient time.)

Course Costs: Apprentices who re-indenture post-trade are fully Government sponsored and must pay only the compulsory student fee (approximately \$600).

This high-level training is also subsidised by the Queensland Government for the purpose of professional development in Queensland Industry, and there will be some places available for non-indentured (no apprenticeship) students at a cost of only \$1,500.

CNC TECHNICIAN

MEM 40105 CERTIFICATE IV IN ENGINEERING

- Course Duration:** The PARTEC training program for apprentices is conducted as flexible attendance over the apprenticeship period to suit employer convenience.
- Who is the Course for:** Persons who need to advance towards a C7 skills classification with CNC specialisation and who hold a Certificate III in Engineering Mechanical.
- Group Size:** Practical work at PARTEC will be closely supervised for health and safety reasons, and personal attention to each participant.
- Course Objective:** To provide high quality CNC skills training for HET apprentices leading to a C7 level trade outcome, which is specialised. PARTEC has the most up-to-date training facilities in Queensland.
- Certification:** Certificate IV in Engineering (MEM 40105).
- Course Venue:** PARTEC Institute. Enquiries to Terry Sturman or Colin Gossip.
- Course Fee:** The cost of the Apprenticeship training at PARTEC is subsidised by the State Government through the User Choice program. There is an annual tuition fee which the State Government requires to be paid to PARTEC for the balance of the cost. (This is approximately \$600 per annum, at current rates.) Method of payment is negotiable. *(Employers are required to reimburse this under current industrial award, on satisfactory progress by the apprentice. The employer can expect a \$3,000 completion bonus from the federal government.)*
- Special Conditions:** When you enter into a Contract of Training (indenture) you need to specify that you want to use PARTEC for training. PARTEC can arrange for assistance to complete all the necessary forms.
- Assessment:** Written tests and a practical assignments portfolio of CNC Programs and machining jobs.
- Certificates:** Certificate IV in Engineering (MEM40105). "CNC-TECHNICIAN".
